1. Days of Studies at the *Thomas Instituut te Utrecht*

On 6 March 2009 the *Thomas Instituut te Utrecht* (Tilburg University) organised a morning of study, aimed at a broad public. The theme of this small symposium – entitled ‘Miserere’ – was Psalm 51 (50), approached from the angles of exegesis and history, of music, and of Aquinas’ explanation of this Psalm.

Harm van Grol, lecturer in the Exegesis of the Old Testament at the Faculty of Catholic Theology (Tilburg University), offered a close reading of the Hebrew original. Martin Hoondert (Tilburg University), an expert in music and Christianity, spoke about and also played different musical expressions of Psalm 51, *Miserere mei*, ranging from the celebrated Gregorio Allegri, to a recent modern setting by the Dutch composer Vermeeren. In the third contribution on the interpretation of the *Miserere*-psalm, Herwi Rikhof, director of the *Thomas Instituut*, studied Aquinas’ explanation of Psalm 51 (50) and showed that Aquinas offers a spiritual and a theological reading of the Psalm, in which the central theme is the mercy of God. 75 people attended this morning of study.

On 23 April 2009 Gilles Emery o.p. from Fribourg University (Switzerland) visited the *Thomas Instituut te Utrecht* for an expert meeting. In front of an audience of thirty people he presented an interesting lecture on the key themes in St. Thomas’ theology of the Trinity, entitled ‘Thomas’ Theology of the Trinity: Leading Ideas’. Emery gave a useful and masterful overview of core elements of Aquinas’ account

of the mystery of the Trinity. Herwi Rikhof, gave a reaction entitled: ‘Thomas’ Theology of the Trinity and the Recent Renaissance of the Theology of the Trinity’. The afternoon concluded with a lively discussion.

2. Research group ‘Thomas Aquinas’

Members of the research group Onderzoeks groep Thomas van Aquino convened seven times in 2009. Papers and articles by members of the Institute were discussed, as well as texts by Thomas Aquinas.

On 24 June the research group spent a day away together in Nijmegen. The morning was spent talking about G.K. Chesterton’s classic *Orthodoxy* (1907). In the afternoon the discussion concentrated on Thomas Aquinas’ thoughts about the Holy Spirit.

3. Chair for Theology of Thomas Aquinas

During the year under review further research at the chair concentrated around the subject of christian salvation. Henk Schoot, extraordinary professor to the Chair for Theology of Thomas Aquinas, wrote an article which was published in the 13th volume of the series *Publications of the Thomas Instituut te Utrecht*: ‘Divine Transcendence and the Mystery of Salvation according to Thomas Aquinas’. As editor of Thomistica he was partly responsible for the reviewing of several publications about Thomas Aquinas for that bibliography.

4. The Board of the Institute and the Foundation

In the year under review the Board of the Institute convened on 20 January, 23 March, 25 May, 7 September, 5 October and 9 November. During the meeting in January the policy and activities of the institute for the next five years were outlined. The situation of the *Thomas Instituut te Utrecht* as part of the

Faculty of Catholic Theology (Tilburg University) was also subject of discussion.

As of 1 September prof. Herwi Rikhof – Director of the *Thomas Instituut te Utrecht* since 1995 – decided to change some of his responsibilities as professor at the Department of Systematic Theology and Philosophy of the Faculty of Catholic Theology (Tilburg University). Subsequently the task as Director has been entrusted to Henk Schoot, who already had taken over some of Herwi Rikhof's tasks and is also professor on the Chair for Theology of Thomas Aquinas. Thus, as of 1 September 2009 Henk Schoot has been appointed Director of the *Thomas Instituut te Utrecht* by the dean of the Faculty of Catholic Theology of Tilburg University.

The *Thomas Instituut te Utrecht* owes professor Rikhof very many thanks for his dedication and inspiration as Director of the Institute in the last fourteen years. During his time as Director many publications of the institute saw the light and several days of study, as well as two international conferences have been held.

Apart from prof. Rikhof, also prof. Rudi te Velde left the Board of the Institute after being member of the board for thirteen years. The Institute owes thanks to him as well.

The Board of the Thomas Foundation convened on 16 April and 3 November 2009. There were no changes in the composition of the Board of the Foundation.

5. Jaarboek Thomas Instituut te Utrecht

The *Jaarboek Thomas Instituut te Utrecht 2008* was timely published in 2009. The Editorial Board convened on 8 June. There were no personnel changes in the Editorial Board.

8. Research programmes and research projects in 2009***The Thought of Thomas Aquinas (philosophical, systematic-theological)***

(Faculty of Catholic Theology, Tilburg University)

The central questions in the research project ‘The Thought of Thomas Aquinas’ are systematic-theological and philosophical in nature. Results of recent historical research are taken into account, but historical research is not the aim of this project. In this project Thomas’ texts are read with systematic questions in mind and with an hermeneutical awareness. This then determines the research’s double perspective: first it focuses on aspects characteristic for Thomas’ thinking, and secondly it takes into account sensitivities that form part of the current (theological and philosophical) situation.

Characteristic for Thomas’ theological thinking is its basis in Holy Scripture, its continuous theocentrism, its negative theology bias, and its attention to the *nexus mysteriorum*. Characteristic for Thomas’ philosophical thinking is his attention to metaphysics. The sensitivities of the current situation relevant for this research are related to the notion of the history of salvation, to subjectivity and to pluralism. Both perspectives are dealt with in the sub-projects.

The research concentrates on a number of interrelated themes: the doctrine of the Trinity, christology and soteriology, theological anthropology, and theory of participation.
