### **1. Research and study at the *Thomas Instituut te Utrecht***

In 2012 research at the Institute continued within the overall research program “Christian Identity in a Pluralistic Context – Continuity and Discontinuity” of Tilburg School of Catholic Theology. Within this overall program three members of the *Thomas Instituut te Utrecht* – Henk Schoot, Rudi te Velde and Harm Goris – are doing research into the ways in which Thomas Aquinas’ philosophy and theology order and formulate Christian identity and thereby constitute a principal source for subsequent tradition.

As in previous years the meetings of the research group ‘Onderzoeks groep Thomas van Aquino’ were part of the curriculum of the Research Master Programme of Tilburg School of Catholic Theology (TST). The research master students participated in the meetings and discussions of the research group, which convened seven times in 2012 with dr. Henk Schoot, director of the Institute, as chair.

On 2 April Adam Eitel from Princeton University, currently studying at the ‘Institut S. Thomas d’Aquin pour la théologie et la culture’ of Fribourg University (CH), visited the research group to discuss his article ‘Making Motions in a Language we do not Understand: The Apophaticism of Thomas Aquinas and Victor Preller’. During the other meetings texts by Thomas Aquinas were read and discussed about as well as papers and articles by members of the Institute.

## **2. Morning of Study at the Thomas Instituut te Utrecht**

On 27 January – on the eve of the feastday of Thomas Aquinas – the Institute organised a morning of study entitled ‘Thomas as Preacher’. Members of the Institute – Mark-Robin Hoogland c.p., Rudi te Velde and Henk Schoot – lectured about Thomas’s academic sermons, following the publication of Hoogland’s English translation of twenty sermons of Thomas Aquinas at The Catholic University of America Press (*Thomas Aquinas. The Academic Sermons. Translated by Mark-Robin Hoogland, C.P.* [The Fathers of the Church: Medieval Continuation, vol. 11] Washington DC 2010).

At the start of the morning the author of this publication gave a thorough introduction into Aquinas as preacher and several of the 20 sermons he had translated. Title of his lecture was: ‘Thomas the Preacher *Rediscoverd*’. After that, Rudi te Velde presented a lecture about Thomas’s sermon *Puer Jesus* and the question of Jesus’ spiritual growth. The third contributor, Henk Schoot, talked about ‘patience’, as theme of Aquinas’ sermons on the Apostles’ Creed and for the feasts of the birth of Mary and *Germinet terra*.

55 people attended the morning of study. The contributions have been published in the *Jaarboek Thomas Instituut 2011* (2012).

## **3. Fourth International Conference 2013**

In the course of 2012, preparations started for the fourth international conference that will be organised by the Thomas Instituut from 11 to 14 December 2013 at Utrecht/Netherlands. The theme of this conference will be ‘Faith, Hope and Love. Thomas Aquinas on Living by the Infused Virtues’. Keynote lectures will be given by: Eleonore Stump (Saint Louis University), Anna Williams (Cambridge University), Paul Waddell (St. Norbert’s College), Bruno Niederbacher

(University of Innsbruck) and Paul van Tongeren (Radboud University Nijmegen). Short lectures and papers will be given by (among others): Henk J.M. Schoot (Thomas Instituut te Utrecht), John O'Callaghan (University of Notre Dame), Michael Sherwin o.p. (University of Fribourg), Rudi te Velde (Thomas Instituut te Utrecht), Lambert Hendriks (Major Seminary Rolduc) and Herwi Rikhof (Thomas Instituut te Utrecht).

#### **4. Chair for Theology of Thomas Aquinas**

According to a decision reached in December 2011 on 1 May 2012 the Chair for Theology of Thomas Aquinas, which had been established in 2006, ceased to exist following several unavailing attempts for additional funding. Though dr. Henk Schoot will continue to act as director of the Institute, and is preparing several new initiatives, such as to establish bonds with potential new members of the Institute and the organization of the fourth international conference of the Institute in December 2013.

#### **5. The Steering Committee of the Institute and the Board of the Thomas Foundation**

The steering committee of the Institute – Director of the Institute, dr. Henk Schoot, the Secretary of Studies, dr. Cristina Pumplun, and dr. Harm Goris – convened on several occasions to discuss preparations for the upcoming fourth international conference in 2013 and the move of the Institute to a new location in the centre of Utrecht, the Institute being part of Tilburg School of Catholic Theology/Tilburg University.

The Board of the Thomas Foundation convened on 10 April and 12 November 2012. The Board welcomed mgr. dr. H. van den Hende, bishop of Rotterdam, and dr. Henk Schoot, director of the Institute, as new members of the Board. During

the meeting on 12 November the Board of the Foundation said good-bye to drs. R.W. Brenninkmeijer. He has been member of the Board of the Thomas Foundation from the very beginning in 1993, when a new board was installed because of the need to organise fund-raising for the Institute in a professional way. The *Thomas Instituut te Utrecht* owes Mr. Brenninkmeijer many thanks for all his work and good advice serving the Thomas Foundation and the Institute.

#### **6. Jaarboek Thomas Instituut te Utrecht**

The *Jaarboek Thomas Instituut te Utrecht 2011* was timely published in 2012. The Editorial Board convened on 12 April and 13 November. There were no personnel changes in the Editorial Board.

#### **7. Translation series**

Cooperation with the *Tiltenberg* (Centre for ecclesiastical education of the diocese Haarlem-Amsterdam) continued in 2012. Work has been done on the Dutch translation of Aquinas' *De articulis Fidei et Ecclesiae sacramentis* and of his *Collationes super Symbolum Apostolorum*. Publication of these translations is planned for the first half of 2013.

## 9. Research programmes and research projects in 2012

### *Tilburg School of Catholic Theology (Tilburg University): Ordering Christian Identity – Thomas Aquinas*

At the *Thomas Instituut te Utrecht* research is done into the ways in which Thomas Aquinas's philosophy and theology order and formulate Christian identity and thereby constitute a principal source for subsequent tradition.

Thomas Aquinas has made important contributions to the formulation of Christian identity in at least three areas: the link he endeavors to establish between metaphysics and belief in God along the lines of being; the theological anthropology he develops, in which the relations between nature, grace and sin are directive; and the way in which his Christology situates salvation through the cross theologically and analyses it conceptually. The concept of 'ordering' is important since establishing links and negotiating approaches and topics constitute Aquinas's strength.

The questions this research program addresses, aim to build up a historically, philosophically and theologically sound interpretation of the thought of Thomas Aquinas in the areas mentioned, to put this interpretation in historical perspective, and to formulate its relevance for contemporary discussions on Christian identity.

An approach is chosen which builds on a more general and innovative interpretation of Thomas which was developed by the Institute during the years past. The program also constitutes a principal contribution to the research program of Tilburg School of Catholic Theology, since it will offer cross-sections of the historical, philosophical and theological development of thought on several topics that define Christian identity.
