

## **ANNUAL REPORT 2008**

### **1. Study and research at the *Thomas Instituut te Utrecht***

On 19 March 2008 Matthew Kostelecky (St. Francis Xavier University, Nova Scotia, Canada) visited the *Thomas Instituut te Utrecht* and gave a paper about Thomas' Commentary on Boethius' *De Trinitate*. Kostelecky was to defend his doctoral thesis at Leuven – titled *The Summa contra gentiles as a Mirror of Human Nature* – two days later. The paper he presented at the Thomas Instituut te Utrecht was entitled 'Whither Metaphysics and Revealed Theology? Some Clues from St. Thomas' Commentary on Boethius' *De Trinitate*'. Kostelecky discussed the continuity of plan, purpose, and method between St. Thomas' commentary on Boethius' *De trinitate* and his *Summa contra gentiles* in order to accomplish two things: 1) shed light onto the perplexing structure of the *ScG*, and 2) give a point of access for understanding Thomas' general approach to the knowledge of divine things. He also tried to show that Thomas' investigation of the methods of coming to know divine things in the *In De trin* determines the order of procedure in the *ScG* and, that by comparing these two works one can see better the conditions that require metaphysics and revealed theology as modes of discourse if we are to speak about God. Fifteen people attended this afternoon of studies at the Thomas Instituut, which was concluded with a lively discussion.

Due to different circumstances, two other initiatives to a common study of respectively Aquinas' concept of theology

and Aquinas' theology of the Trinity unfortunately had to be cancelled.

Members of the research group *Onderzoeks groep Thomas van Aquino* convened seven times in 2008, each time on the first Monday of the month to discuss papers and articles by members of the Institute and to read texts by Thomas Aquinas.

## **2. Chair for Theology of Thomas Aquinas**

During the year under review further research at the chair concentrated around the subject of Christ's Satisfaction and Passion. Henk Schoot, extraordinary professor to the Chair for Theology of Thomas Aquinas, wrote an article which will be published in the 13<sup>th</sup> volume of the *Publications of the Thomas Instituut te Utrecht*: 'Divine transcendence and the mystery of salvation according to Thomas Aquinas'. He also became editor of *Thomistica* and therefore is partly responsible for the reviewing of several publications about Thomas Aquinas for that bibliography.

## **3. The Board of the Institute and the Foundation**

The Board of the Institute convened on 15 January, 26 March, 1 September and 3 November. The situation of the *Thomas Instituut te Utrecht* as part of the Faculty of Catholic Theology (Tilburg University) had to be discussed intensely during these meetings, as well as the activities of the Institute. There were no changes in the composition of the Board of the Institute.

The Board of the Thomas Foundation convened on 26 March. There were no changes in the composition of the Board of the Foundation.

**4. Jaarboek Thomas Instituut te Utrecht**

The *Jaarboek Thomas Instituut te Utrecht 2007* was timely published in 2008. The Editorial Board convened on 15 January and 26 May. There were no personnel changes in the Editorial Board.

In the year under review the *Jaarboek Thomas Instituut te Utrecht* has been considered eligible for inclusion in the ‘ERIH Initial List: Philosophy’ of the European Science Foundation with the notation ‘C’.

**5. Series of Publications**

In the year under review the last preparations were done for the 13<sup>th</sup> volume in the series of the Institute, which will be published as *Divine Transcendence and Immanence in the Work of Thomas Aquinas*. Editors are Harm Goris, Herwi Rikhof and Henk Schoot, publisher is Peeters at Louvain.

**6. Translation Series**

With substantial support of the Thomas Foundation the fourth volume in the series of Dutch translations of the Institute appeared. ‘Is it allowed to kill a human being?’ – under this question Carlo Leget has published a Latin-Dutch translation of parts of *quaestiones* 10, 11, 40, 64, 124 and 188 of the *STh II-II*. The book contains the Latin original texts as well as the translation, an introduction and annotations: Thomas van Aquino, *Mag je een mens doden? Teksten uit de Summa Theologiae over God, geloof en geweld*. De Latijnse tekst, ingeleid, vertaald en geannoteerd door Carlo Leget, Meinema/Zoetermeer 2008, 112 pp.

## 8. Research programmes and research projects in 2008

*The Thought of Thomas Aquinas (philosophical, systematic-theological)*

(Faculty of Catholic Theology, Tilburg University)

The central questions in the research project ‘The Thought of Thomas Aquinas’ are systematic-theological and philosophical in nature. Results of recent historical research are taken into account, but historical research is not the aim of this project. In this project Thomas’ texts are read with systematic questions in mind and with an hermeneutical awareness. This then determines the research’s double perspective: first it focuses on aspects characteristic for Thomas’ thinking, and secondly it

takes into account sensitivities that form part of the current (theological and philosophical) situation.

Characteristic for Thomas' theological thinking is its basis in Holy Scripture, its continuous theocentrism, its negative theology bias, and its attention to the *nexus mysteriorum*. Characteristic for Thomas' philosophical thinking is his attention to metaphysics. The sensitivities of the current situation relevant for this research are related to the notion of the history of salvation, to subjectivity and to pluralism. Both perspectives are dealt with in the sub-projects.

The research concentrates on a number of interrelated themes: the doctrine of the Trinity, christology and soteriology, theological anthropology, and theory of participation.
